Expand your collection of modern German passenger trains with the introduction of the DB BR 648 to Train Simulator.

The DB BR 648 is a two-car diesel multiple unit (DMU) built by Alstom as part of their Coradia family of multiple units. The LINT sub-class – of which the BR 648 is part of - stands for 'Leichter Innovativer Nahverkehrstriebwagen' (Light Innovative Local Transport Rail Vehicle), as it is designed to operate on regional stopping services across non-electrified track.

The two halves of the unit rest on shared 'Jacobs' bogies to improve stability, reduce weight and production costs, and lower noise levels of the wheels on the rails. With a total of 422hp, a top speed of 120km/h (75mph) and space for 115 passengers, this DMU has all it needs to manage the more rural scene in Northern Germany, connecting smaller towns with the big cities such as Lübeck or Neumünster.

The BR 648 is designed with accessibility in mind, featuring low floors to allow for faster, step free access for passengers, and wheelchair accessible facilities. The floor itself has been designed to absorb and reduce sound that comes from the diesel engines and the exhaust heat from the engines is used to heat the cabin of the unit. Some of the seating is also raised higher than the low floor to distance passengers from the noise and cushion the vibration of the engine.

The BR 648 for Train Simulator is available in Deutsche Bahn Traffic Red livery and recreates the DMU as it operates today for DB on the Hamburg-Lübeck Railway route.

The locomotive is also Quick Drive compatible, giving you the freedom to drive the DB BR 648 on any Quick Drive enabled route for Train Simulator, such as those available through Steam. Also included are scenarios specifically for the Hamburg-

<u>Lübeck Railway</u> route (available separately and required to play these scenarios).



Its great to have 2016 schemes, but it is unnessasary to remake schemes that were already there. But more schemes than that were in the season. Looking to pick up this game because why pay for a casual game? Keep moving. The item drop rate in this game is completely screwed and you wind up picking up quests that are impossible to finish before the game is even half done.

If that wasn't bad enough, the game has some really weird design choices. Like, chaining together finds gives you extra items. Sounds like a great thing, right? Well the bonus items pop up on the screen, obscuring the play area and making it even harder to continue chaining finds.. Toki Tori is a cute little puzzle game. It's suitable for kids and puzzle fans, and not so suitable for platforming enthusiasts.

I got the game on sale for \$0.43 and can't complain about the purchase. Not sure I'll be playing through all the levels, though.. Fun little mecha 2d shoot em up. Sequel to gigantic army. Very forgiving compared to gigantic army, and that is not a bad thing. Has even a save system. Mouse and keyboard feels best for this but 360 pad works fine too.. it's just too easy to pummel the computer and the fleet battles aren't set up so that you can actually employ formations or tactics; they just devolve into an uncontrollable scrum where the fleet that has the best first barrage will win.. Take Jalopy and throw in a good heaping of Mad Max and you get Under The Sand. The game is still light on content at the moment, it only takes an hour or so to reach the end of the road. However, this game has received near-daily updates since it's early-access debut, which is my biggest reason for recommending this game. With more content, polish and possibly a little something to set it apart from Jalopy, Under The Sand could easily become one of the biggest indie hits of 2019.

This game essentially bridges them all together in a nice little package.

Altogether Steel Strider is an amazing game. Upgrading the various sprites from previous games and making the gameplay more exciting. The battles are more interesting and fast paced as well as featuring enemies from the previous games.. This is the best software for making games, every thing in the video is true, exept its better!. I had to mess around with my graphics card menu for a while to get the game running at the full frame rate, and once I did I at first thought the game was actually running way too fast. Given the trailer I think it was about right though, so I forged ahead. At this incredible game speed, with only 1 hp, the game actually wraps around from "fast-paced" back to slow again, because you can't react to things, you can only employ cheap tactics that let you eliminate the enemies without really fighting them. Like purposefully going in front of a security camera, then throwing incredible bouncing shuriken down the hallway as the entire level's force rushes out in a line to meet you.

Speaking of shuriken, shuriken (and bullets) that you fire bounce back and hit you in the face a lot of the time, it's ridiculous.

The setting reminds me of Blade, if Blade was a bad movie. The aesthetics look a bit like a bizarre art movie I saw once about being abducted by aliens when doing drugs.

It's even movie-length, what a convenient coincidence.
